ATC Formation

"... In meeting this obligation, the ATC LLC shall treat the needs of each electric distribution system interconnected to the ATC LLC's system, and the electric loads on each system, in a non-discriminatory manner."

Project Services Agreement & Common Facilities Agreement

- Jointly filed with PSCW in June 2007
- Order anticipated in early 2009
- Result of 18 months of collaborative work with customers
- CFA standardizes annual process for compensating substation owner for pro rata share of common expenses (i.e., snow removal, weed control, etc.)
 - Covers any entity with whom we share substation common facilities
- PSA standardizes method for parties to request work to be performed on their behalf
 - Eliminates Transitional Services Agreement
 - Removes requirement for individual Affiliated Interest Agreement filings with PSC in Wisconsin
 - UPPCO and Edison Sault are affiliates
